LOCATION

Situated on Barbados' famous St. James beach, with gracious accommodation and activities to accommodate your every pleasure.

ACCOMMODATION

The accommodation is gracious, spacious, well-appointed and fully air-conditioned, equipped with amply stocked mini-bars, radios and telephones.

Delightfully set amidst luxurious tropical gardens, all rooms have balconies or patios where you can enjoy breakfast or afternoon tea and later quietly relax after the sun and fun.

There are *Deluxe Rooms* and *Club Rooms* that overlook the beach, while the *Superior Rooms* enjoy pleasing views of the gardens or pool area. But wherever you choose to stay, because of careful design and seaside location, there isn't a place that isn't far from the water's edge.

DINING

Children's menu is always available as well as early dinner sittings.

There are two buffets and one BBQ per week, the remainder of the evenings is table d'hôte and à la carte dining. Guests requiring a table of 5 or more persons are requested to make arrangements in advance with the head waiter. There are also numerous restaurants in the area within walking distance.

BARS

The Beach Bar is open from 10:00 am – 5:30 pm. Happy hour at the Beach Bar is 4:30 pm – 5:30 pm (except Mondays). The main bar is open from 5:30 pm – 11:30 pm. Room service is available for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

DRESS CODE

It is not necessary for gentlemen to wear jackets and ties, however, we do stipulate that beach wear, shorts or T-Shirts should not be worn in the restaurant or main bar after 5:30 pm.



ACTIVITIES

The recreational facilities are wide and varied, including tennis courts, table tennis equipment, shuffle board, beach lounges and towels, Manager's Weekly Rum Swizzle Party, hotel raft, all provided compliments of Discovery Bay. Scuba diving, water skiing, deep sea fishing, parasailing, hobie cat sailing, jet skiing, horse-back riding, island tours and car rentals can all be easily arranged through the front desk

Currency	Both US and Barbados Dollars are widely accepted throughout Barbados.
Electricity	The voltage is 110 V AC 50 cycles. Adaptors are available from the Front Office, where a deposit will be taken, refundable on the return of the adaptor.
Laundry	Laundry is sent to an outside vendor and takes two days.
Morning Calls	Wake up calls should be requested on previous evening through the front desk.
Hairdressers	There is a hairdressing salon on the premises. Reception will be happy to make appointments for you.
Hairdryers	Available from reception.
Baby Sitters	Are available at the cost of US \$6.50 per hour. After midnight, the cost is US \$7.50 per hour.
Banks	There are four banks in the Hotetown area. Hours of operation: Mon-Thurs 08:00 – 15:00 hrs Fri 08:00 – 17:00 hrs
Entertainment	Regular live entertainment is offered in the evenings.
Safety Deposit Boxes	Provided at reception – Management does not accept any responsibility for losses if safety deposit boxes are not used.
Beaches	All beaches in Barbados are public. It is possible to walk along the beach to many other bays on the West coast.
Beach Towels	Beach towels are placed in your room for your convenience. These towels will be exchanged daily by the room attendant, therefore please ensure used ones are left in the room for collection.
Shopping	There is a supermarket, a pharmacy and individual speciality shops within walking distance in Hometown. More varied shopping is available in Bridgetown, the capital, 20 minutes drive away. There is one boutique on the premises, selling beachware and sundries.
Public Transport	Buses run every 15 minutes. The nearest bus stop is just opposite from the hotel. The fare is US75cents for any distance.
Taxi Service	Taxis are available from the main entrance or Reception can call one for you.
Mail	Postage stamps and postcards are available at Reception.
Tour Excursions, Self Drive	The Reception desk will be delighted to arrange island tours and excursions for clients who do not have a local representative.
Telephone/Telex/Fax	All available through the Front Office. Long distance telephone calls and faxes are subject to an additional charge (usually around 50%)
